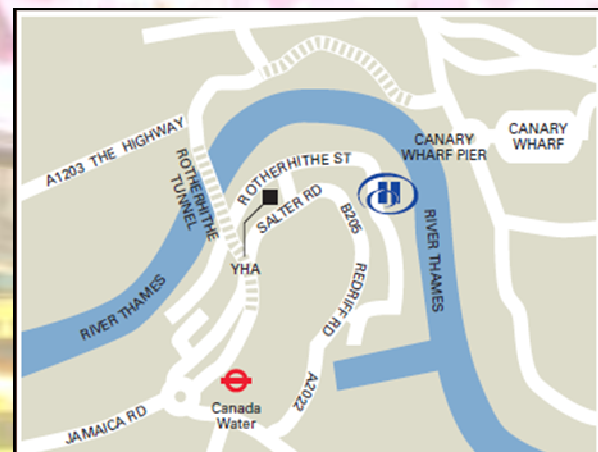
Accommodation
