

RD-UK SPECIALTY TRAINEE AWARDS- 2023 UPDATE

In celebration of the 50th anniversary of Restorative Dentistry as a specialty, RD-UK is pleased to announce this year we will be awarding multiple Specialty Trainee Awards, each up to a value of £1000.00.

Applicants must be an Associate member of RD-UK (via membership through SRRDG) and in an approved programme for specialist training in either Restorative Dentistry or one of the monospecialties, on the day the application is submitted.

The application must be supported by a full member of RD-UK. The Award will be made as either:

- a. A Travel Award, to enhance the applicant's specialist training, by supporting international travel for an elective visit to another clinical centre. Due to ongoing COVID restrictions in some countries, this year we will also be allowing awards for domestic travel.
- b. A Quality Award, for development and use of a quality improvement process, within the speciality of Restorative Dentistry.

The Council may choose to divide the award between a number of successful applicants, each year, dependent on the quality and appropriateness of applications received. Each successful applicant will be expected to make a short presentation regarding their award at the subsequent Annual Meeting of RD-UK.

Written applications of not more than 500 words, summarising the type and nature of award applied for, can be made at any time to the Honorary Secretary of RD-UK (ishpinder.Toor@gstt.nhs.uk). They will be considered by the RD-UK council at the next scheduled council meeting. The closing date for 2023 will be 5pm on 8th September 2023.

A judging panel of at least three Council members, appointed by the Honorary Secretary, will assess each application and a decision will be made at the Autumn RD-UK Council meeting (September 2023). Payment of the award will be made on review of all relevant receipts.

Council reserves the right not to make an award if no suitable applications are received. Each successful applicant will be informed as soon as possible after that Council meeting.
